DON'T STUDY GRAMMAR RULES.

USE THE POINT OF VIEW TECHNIQUE



**A very common problem
among English students:**

**They have a hard time
remembering what they learn.**

**It's common that you learn something
in English, and, after certain time,
you forget almost everything.**

**This is very frustrating, and it may
hurt your motivation over time.**

**In many language schools they try
to cover as much material as possible.**

**This way the students learn superficially,
so they don't consolidate what they learn.**

How can you avoid this?

How can you learn

English **in-depth**?

Here's a vital approach that will save you a lot of time:

“LEARN BY REPETITION”

This approach may seem simple,
but it's very powerful.

“LEARN BY REPETITION”

**Let's say you have 20-30 minutes of
easy audio content in English.**

For example a story or a podcast.

If you have the text in English, it's much better.

**For example, 2 or 3 times per day,
over the course of one week.**

**You can read the transcript
at the same time or just listen.**

**Do it even if you think you have
already learned the words!!**

Why so many times?

Because your brain needs many **repetitions** to acquire new vocabulary, new grammar structures, pronunciation, etc.

After one week you can move on and choose a different material.

**I can guarantee you that this
technique is very powerful.**

Many people tell me that I am very fortunate to speak eight different languages but I can assure you that this technique is quite common among polyglots.

This technique is especially important if you haven't consolidated your English.

**My premium English courses follow
specifically this philosophy, allowing the
student to quickly consolidate their

**You have to use a system where once you
have learned something you will remember
it for months, years, forever.**

If you have audio content in English, create a schedule to listening to the same content at least over the course of one week, every day.

After some time you will notice the difference!
