RULE #3.

LEARN BY REPETITION!

**What I mean by automatic speaking is
that you don't translate in your mind
while speaking or listening.**

ENGLISH BECOMES ALIVE!

At this stage you can speak English fluently.

That should be your ultimate goal.

And please, keep this in mind:

**FLUENCY DOESN'T
MEAN PERFECTION!**

Fluency doesn't mean speaking without mistakes.

When children speak, they usually make a lot of mistakes, but they improve over time.

It's natural to make mistakes in the process of learning a new language.

**How can you speak
fluently, automatically?**

**TO SPEAK BETTER, LISTEN TO A LOT OF
COMPREHENSIBLE CONTENT.**

**By LISTENING a lot you're improving
your comprehension skills.**

You'll get used to how the language is naturally spoken, making it unnecessary to translate in your mind.

This is very powerful!

Listening to comprehensible content on a daily basis is called "the input approach", and it has been proven very successful.

**Understand the material you choose
because this is how your brain will be
able to learn the language.**

**The quality of the audio and having
the transcripts is also important.**

I spoke about the Q&A technique, used extensively in my premium English courses. This technique is absolutely amazing when it is executed correctly.

Let me show you how it works to better illustrate the idea.

It consists of many questions and answers which are creating a meaningful story throughout the lesson.

The story provides rich context, which we've seen is great, and the questions and answers help you to practice many aspects of English.

Here's how a typical lesson included in my courses works:

- 1. I say a sentence in English which is about the story.**
- 2. I ask questions in English about that sentence.**
- 3. After each question, there is a pause and you can answer in English.**
- 4. I provide a correct answer in English and I repeat the process (from point 1).**



**Let me show you an example

Here I say several sentences. Then, I ask different questions, where you can answer.

The story goes on and on, with more information, more questions and more answers.

The questions are usually quite easy.

**After some practice, you'll find
yourself answering the questions
effortlessly and automatically!**

In the United States. He was born in the United States.

1. It's a simulation of a conversation. You're practicing your conversational skills.
2. It makes you quickly answer easy questions over and over, helping you to automate your speaking.
3. Because it's recorded, you can practice your answers alone, with no anxiety, doing as many repetitions as you need.
